MISSION GALVESTON

A ministry of Galveston Baptist Association, established in 1998 with a few volunteers and \$100.00. Mission Galveston's purpose was to help the homeless and assist the low income family with their spiritual and their physical needs. We are open every Mondays from 9 am to 11 am for homeless.

MISSION TEXAS CITY

A few years later we established a branch of Mission Galveston in Texas City called Mission Texas City to focus on the low income families in that community opens every Saturdays from 9 am to 11 am. Every week we serve/minister to an average of 60 to 65 people and provide them with worship services, food, clothing, and hygiene items.

MINISTRY IN INDIA

Seven years ago Mission Galveston started its outreach to overseas. Mission Galveston started its first Orphanage in Kerala, India. **Home of Hope Orphanage** we presently have 18 boys.

Every year Mission Galveston does a 15 day Mission Trip to Kerala, India. While we are there we hold a **vacation Bible School** for the local Children.

2011 Mission Galveston opened a **Sewing Institute** for ladies in poor villages and 30 ladies graduated from that sewing school last year.



2012 January Mission Galveston started a **Computer Institute** for the local people doesn't have the means to attend the regular expensive computer institute. We have 42 students studying in that institute.



This year Mission Galveston is getting ready to undertake a big challenge in the southern part of India. Work among the **HIV community** by providing them with food, vitamins and medication. Also assist the Children of HIV families with their education.
